Membership in the CMMG

Eligibility

The major criteria for membership in the CMMG are active interests in teaching and research dealing with molecular medicine or genetics.

Categories of Membership

There are 4 categories of membership in the CMMG: Primary, Joint, Associate and Adjunct.

1. Primary membership is conferred upon scientists holding a full and primary academic appointment in the CMMG, having a major research and/or teaching interest in molecular medicine or genetics, and participating in the day-to-day activities of CMMG. **Primary membership** includes the following:

- voting privileges in CMMG faculty meetings
- possibility to be a mentor to students of the Graduate Program in Molecular Biology and Genetics and other CMMG educational programs
- priority access to CMMG shared resources and facilities for the support of research. Regular CMMG mailings, both electronically and by campus mail, highlighting research seminars and other educational symposia
- other membership privileges as they become available

2. Joint membership is conferred upon scientists holding an academic appointment in another department of Wayne State University and having a major research and/or teaching interest in molecular medicine or genetics. **Joint membership** includes the following:

- voting privileges in CMMG faculty meetings
- possibility to be a mentor to students of the Graduate Program in Molecular Biology and Genetics and other CMMG educational programs
- priority access to CMMG shared resources and facilities for the support of research. Regular CMMG mailings, both electronically and by campus mail, highlighting research seminars and other educational symposia
- other membership privileges as they become available

3. Associate membership is conferred upon scientists holding an academic appointment in another department of Wayne State University and having a research and/or teaching interest in molecular medicine or genetics, and an on-going research project together with a Primary or Joint Member.

Associate membership includes the following:

- possibility to be a co-mentor (together with a Primary or Joint Member) to students of the Graduate Program in Molecular Biology and Genetics and other CMMG educational programs
- access to CMMG shared resources and facilities for the support of research. Regular CMMG mailings, both electronically and by campus mail, highlighting research seminars and other educational symposia
- other membership privileges as they become available

4. Adjunct membership is conferred upon scientists holding an appointment in another research institution and having a research and/or teaching interest in molecular medicine or genetics. The category of Adjunct Member is suitable for investigators collaborating with CMMG investigators. **Adjunct membership** includes the following:

- possibility to be a co-mentor (together with a Primary or Joint Member) to students of the Graduate Program in Molecular Biology and Genetics and other CMMG educational programs
- access to CMMG shared resources and facilities for the support of research. Regular CMMG mailings, both electronically and by campus mail, highlighting research seminars and other educational symposia
- reduced admission fees to CMMG sponsored symposia
- other membership privileges as they become available

Review of Membership Applications

Applications for Joint, Associate, and Adjunct Membership shall be forwarded to the Director of CMMG for initial review and presentation to the Faculty Recruitment Committee of CMMG. The committee will make recommendations at Faculty meetings for faculty-level Membership. The final approval for the Membership will be granted by the Dean after consideration by the Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate of the School of Medicine. All appointments are made in agreement of regulations of the School of Medicine and any other University wide appointment regulations.

Initial review of the membership application shall be based primarily on interest in molecular medicine and genetics, and already initiated collaborative research projects with Primary or Joint Members of the CMMG. All members are expected to actively contribute towards the goals and mission of the CMMG. Primary and joint members are expected to allocate 3% of the direct expenses of their external grant support for the maintenance and up-grading of the core facilities. Those members who wish to be mentors or co-mentors of graduate students are expected to support the students financially and participate in the teaching of graduate courses. Associate and Adjunct memberships are granted for a three-year term, and renewal of membership shall be based upon productivity and participation in CMMG activities.

Application Procedure

- Application shall be made by submission of an application form; a curriculum vitae; one page description of research interests and major scientific accomplishments; an abstract page of a joint grant application together with a Primary or Joint Member of the CMMG, or one page summary of research project with a Primary or Joint Member of the CMMG; and a letter of support from a Primary Member of the CMMG.
