Students will typically conduct research in the laboratory of one faculty member approximately 40 hours per week and will attend biweekly research seminars. *Applicants taking additional weekday courses at Wayne State or other institutions are not eligible for this research program.* A stipend of \$3,000 will be provided for the 10-week program.
